MISSION

The Friends Advisory Board (the “Board”) serve as advisors to further the mission and goals of the Friends. The Board will work with the Dean of University Libraries to help establish the Friends, provide ongoing support, assist in planning events as needed, and provide guidance to the Dean of University Libraries and the Office of the President of the University to further the Friends’ mission and goals. The Board will also support goals and activities of the Friends by attending cultural events, stimulating membership in the Friends, encouraging gifts to the University Libraries, and alerting the Dean of University Libraries to potential donors or collections of interest. The following are library names and locations on the lakeside campuses: Cudahy Library [Lake Shore Campus], Lewis Library [Water Tower Campus], and the Information Commons [Lake Shore Campus] (the “University Libraries”).
